Ethics

- Members should make sure they understand other members before agreeing or disagreeing with them.
- All members should feel free to speak what they want to say
- All members should present their findings to the Association.
- Every member should be considerate in their responses while listening to the speaker.
- Everyone should try to interact with each other.
- All problems should be put to the side.
