Sub: Request for Depanelling Hospitals not extending CGHS Rates under CPRMSE & CPRMSNE

Dear Sir,

Coal India Ltd. has implemented a Contributory Post Retirement Medicare Scheme called CPRMSE for retired executives and CPRMSNE for retired non-executives. Under these schemes, CIL and its subsidiaries are extending medical facilities to the retired employees and/or their spouses in CIL Hospitals along with 342 empanelled hospitals across India where employees prefer to stay after retirement.

These schemes present a very rosy picture at the first glance, but after years of their implementations, retirees are now realising the dark side of these schemes they being unable to avail hassle free cashless treatment for themselves and their dependents. No doubt, CIL is a Maharatna company but its beneficiaries are losers in every respect. Situation worsens as even these hospitals are refusing to extend CGHS Rates to beneficiaries who are forced to pay at higher rates for availing medical care on payment basis.

Almost all hospitals refuse cashless treatment, do not extend CGHS rates for treatment and due payments/re-imbusement to willing hospitals and employees are delayed abnormally. During our interaction at CIL, HQ in February, 2020 we were given to understand that things will improve soon, but delayed release of hospital dues could not be sorted out and hospitals are compelled to violate MOU.

Similar delayed payments are known to occur elsewhere in other organizations also and violations also occur with CGHS-empanelled hospitals too, but, CGHS takes stern actions by de-panelling such hospitals, as is clear from the copy of one such order by CGHS against a hospital erring on this account (copy enclosed as Annexure-I).

We demand that similar de-panelling be done by CIL also against hospitals violating MOU with CIL by refusing cashless treatment and charging more than CGHS rates.

OFFICE ORDER

M/s. Apollo Hospitals, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad, has failed to extend credit facilities to CGHS beneficiaries and charged over and above CGHS Tariff Rates, in contravention of terms and conditions of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed with CGHS, Hyderabad.

M/s. Apollo Hospitals, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad was warned several times and issued show cause notices, but neither responded to them nor failed to adhere to terms and conditions of empanelment.

It has been therefore, decided to **depanel** M/s. Apollo Hospitals, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad, from the empanelled list of HCOs of CGHS, Hyderabad.

Since, the Clauses 4, 6 & 7 of the MOA have been time and again violated by M/s. Apollo Hospitals, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad, thus attracting Clause 18 of the said MOA, **the Performance Bank Guarantee stands forfeited.**
